Canalside

The waterfront development project is well underway. Architectural Masterpieces

Theater

You'll find Broadway musicals at Shea's Performing Arts Center; classic and contemporary musicals at MusicalFare Theatre; the greatest works of dramatic literature at the Irish Classical Theatre Company; pieces by African-Americans and people of color at Ujima Theatre and the Paul Robeson Theatre; and work by up-and-coming and undiscovered playwrights at the Alleyway Theatre.

Frank Lloyd Wright Filling Station

A newly-opened Frank Lloyd Wright design that was never built in the architect's lifetime. This gem is a 1920s-designed filling station that was built inside the Buffalo Transportation/Pierce-Arrow Museum. Built to Wright's blueprints and specifications, topped with authentic Tydol Oil signs, and features an extensive copper roof, two 45-foot poles that Wright called "totems", red and white painted concrete, and overhead gravity fed tanks.

Larkin Square

Larkin Square, is one of the most compelling neighborhood revivals in Buffalo in recent years. Once the industrial center of town, this southeast Buffalo neighborhood is now one of the city's most popular gathering spots, complete with alfresco dining, live music, microbrews, outdoor markets and hula hoops . Admission to all the events is free.
